**OFFICIAL RULES**

**How to Gain Entry:**

1. Any Muckleshoot Indian Tribal or Community member ages 18 years or older can enter (NO CHILDREN ALLOWED) and play in this FREE (no cost to enter) 10 Regular Game event and Door Prize Drawings.
2. Muckleshoot Indian Tribe Members must show valid tribal ID at the door for entry.
3. Muckleshoot Indian Tribal Community members must show current employee badge or current business card at the door for entry.
4. MIB Employees are limited to 2 immediate family members that can attend this event and they must accompany the two immediate family members at the door for entry.
5. Every participant who attends this event will receive one door prize drawing ticket when they receive their free 9-ON at the registration table.

**How to Be Selected:**

Regular Bingo Games:

1. Regular game winners will get to choose ONE prize from either the Tier 1 or Tier 2 Prize Tables.

Door Prizes:

1. The Muckleshoot Bingo Management Team will randomly select a numbered raffle ticket from the drawing bin located on the caller stand.

**How to Play/Win:**

Regular Bingo Games:

1. Participant must use a dauber on all bingo papers.
2. Participant must daub his/her own bingo paper.
3. Participant must cover all of the needed numbers in the bingo pattern to win.
4. Participant must announce bingo loud enough to stop play.
5. Single Game and Multiple Game Winners will get to choose ONE prize from the Tier 1 or Tier 2 prize table, unless there are 6 or more multiple game winners, then:
  - Multiple Game Winners of 6 or more will receive an additional raffle ticket for a special drawing to award one winner the option to choose one prize from the Tier 1 or Tier 2 prize table.
  - One raffle ticket will be randomly selected to win the one prize.

- All other multiple game winners will get a consolation prize including one Coupon Book and a \$20 Good Neighbor Free Play coupon.
6. Participants who win more than one game as a single game or multiple game winner of less than 6 will get to choose ONE prize from the Tier 2 prize table.

#### Door Prizes:

1. Participants must put their raffle ticket into the Door Prize Raffle Bin located on the Caller Stand before 12:30 pm on Tuesday, December 6.
2. Participants may only have ONE raffle ticket in the drawing bin and can't accept any other raffle tickets for this drawing.
3. After the 10 Regular Game Session ends, the Muckleshoot Bingo Management Team will randomly select a numbered raffle ticket from the Door Prize Raffle Bin located on the caller stand.
4. The Muckleshoot Bingo Management Team will announce the winning raffle ticket number and the person with the winning raffle ticket number will have one (1) minute to identify themselves and report to the callers stand.
5. If the person with the winning raffle ticket number does not identify themselves or report to the callers stand within 1 minute, another winning raffle ticket number will be selected.
6. Winning participants will get to choose any prize left from the Tier 1 or Tier 2 prize tables.
7. Participants can only win the door prize raffle one time.
8. After each drawing the winning raffle ticket will be removed from the drawing bin and no longer eligible to win again.

#### General Rules:

1. The Muckleshoot Indian Tribe, any other contest sponsor, and their affiliated entities and their respective officers and employees shall be released and discharged from any and all claims, losses, injuries, demands, or actions which arise out of or are in any way related to the prize(s), the receipt, use or enjoyment of prize(s), or damages or losses related to the contest.
2. The Tribe reserves the right to postpone, suspend, or terminate the promotion or amend the rules at any time without notice to participants.
3. By entering or participating in the promotion, participants grant Muckleshoot Indian Tribe and its affiliated entities the right to use their names, likeness, or voice for promotional purposes without further compensation or permission.
4. Prizes may not be traded or transferred. Substitution of cash, or equivalent for noncash prizes unless expressly stated in the contest rules is not permitted, provided that, in the event that the Tribe at its sole discretion reserves the right to substitute cash in the event that a noncash prize becomes unavailable. In accepting a prize, the winner accepts the prize "as is" with no warranties
5. Winners of promotional contests will be required to present valid photo identification acceptable to the Tribe, social security number, and complete an IRS Form W-9 and a winner release form before a promotional contest prize will be awarded. Failure to provide required identification and complete required IRS Form W-9 and a winner release may result in forfeiture of promotional contest prizes.
6. Participants acknowledge that Prizes may be subject to tax withholding requirements under applicable federal regulations and that payouts may be reduced due to withholding requirements. Winners agree to pay all expenses, taxes and fees not included in the prize.

The Tribe will report winnings in excess of \$600 in cash or fair market value during a calendar year to the IRS and such winners will receive and IRS Form 1099.

7. For promotional contests that require physical participation, selected participants who are physically unable to participate may designate a person other than an employee of Muckleshoot Casino or Bingo to participate on their behalf.
8. Participants are responsible for hearing contest announcements and the Tribe shall not be responsible in any manner for the failure of a participant to hear or respond to contest announcements. In promotional contests involving a drawing, in case of public address system failure the drawing may continue and in such event the selected participant's name will be announced without amplification at the drawing location.
9. The Tribe is not responsible for lost or stolen entries, or coupons, computer malfunctions or other incidents resulting in loss of entries.
10. The Tribe is not responsible for inability to enter a drawing due to long lines or other causes.
11. Muckleshoot Indian Tribe and Community members are the only participants allowed to enter this promotion. Muckleshoot Bingo Management will determine what is considered a community member if an issue arises.
12. MIB Employees and up to TWO immediate family members are allowed to enter this promotion.
13. Self-barred patrons may play in this FREE Event.
14. Entries are not transferable.
15. Violation of contest rules may result in disqualification.
16. Muckleshoot Bingo house rules apply.
17. Any participant dissatisfied with a decision/ruling in this promotion may, within thirty (30) days of the disputed decision/ruling, submit their complaint in the form of a written petition for relief to the Muckleshoot Gaming Commission.
